

Roche expands its Global Analytics and Technology Center of Excellence

- Sets up its second data analytics center in Hyderabad
- Invests strategically to develop Data Science and Advanced Analytics capabilities

Hyderabad, 18 October 2022: With an aim to provide innovative data driven solutions, Roche Pharma has set up its second state-of-the-art Global Analytics and Technology Centers of Excellence (GATE) in India at Hyderabad.
